Instructions for Station 2/6

Article Analysis


You will be working individually or in groups to **read**, **annotate** and **analyze** an article (You have a choice.) By the end of the period you should have your article annotated, 4 words in Frayer Models, and the article analysis completed.

Materials Managers - Show your team the folder of newspaper articles and let them choose one each. It does not have to be the same article. Give the Article Analysis Sheet to each member of your team. You will also need dictionaries from the shelves under the projector screen.

Step 1 - Read the Newspaper Article, first for fluency. Then with a pen/pencil, annotate the article like Mrs. Martin has shown you - marking main ideas and key information. Remember - when you underline, you must write a note in the margin explaining why you underline.

Step 2 - Fill out the article analysis sheet. Notice that it requires **complete** sentences.

Step 3 - Select four words from the article that you chose. Complete a Frayer Model for each of the words. Place your Frayer models on the back of the folded article and Article Analysis sheets that you have glued in.



Step 4 - Glue the handouts:

Glue the annotated article to **page 114** of the Interactive Notebook. Glue the Article Analysis to **Page 115** of the Interactive Notebook.
