

Instructions for Station 3/7

Africa Geography Challenge

You will be working as a group examining the map placards at your station and answering questions about **Africa** geography. The station requires students to use a variety of thematic maps to find information. The challenge is to figure out which of the thematic maps answer the question and to use them to answer all 10 questions.

Step 2 - In the manila folders you will find five placards with five types of thematic maps of **Africa**. Materials Managers should pass one of each type to all members of your team so that all can participate. There may not be enough for all members so you may need to share with a shoulder partner. There is an extra political map showing the rest of Africa on the back of these instructions.

Step 3 - Pass out the handouts called "Africa Geo-Challenge Part 1 and Part 2." The handouts with are glued to **pages 70 and 71**. Complete all 10 questions. Work together as a team all on the same question each looking at their maps.

Step 4 - When you are done with the questions, place the placards back into their correct folder. Materials Managers will confirm that all back in the correct folder.
